

How do I submit my website to search engines?

Submitting websites to search engines is actually an outdated practice and is no longer supported by search engines. Nowadays, major search engines such as Google, automatically crawl and index newly created websites.

 html tag. Those words are what a browser will display in its title bar. Generally don't put more than 10 words there.

2. Use <META> tags. They provide additional info to search engines to better index your site. You add them between the <HEAD> tags. For example:

<div style="margin-left: 40px;" mce_style="margin-left: 40px;"><META name="description" content="Describe your website in a phrase or sentence">
<META name="keywords" content="keywords, short phrases, that, describe, your site">
</div>
3. Don't spam search engines by repeating keywords many times in the above tags or use keyword not relevant to your site. If you do so, most search engines will just exclude your site.
